DEATH: GENEVA D. CLEGG

Geneva Denison Clegg, 90, passed away April 13, 1995 in American Fork, Utah.

She was born June 23, 1904 in Manti, Utah to Hyrum and Katharina Barbara Stutznegger Denison. Geneva was raised in a family of 12 children in Manti, Utah, where she attended grade school and graduated from Manti High School. She attended BYU, where she received a teaching certificate. She taught school in Horsehead, Utah (near Monticello), in a one room school house; then at Bluff, Utah, and at Clarion, Utah. She came to Heber City to teach at the North School, and met and married Almon Giles Clegg. They were married on June 17, 1928 in the Manti LDS Temple. They lived their entire married lives in Heber City. He preceded her in death July 9, 1989.

Geneva was a gifted musician and teacher and a dedicated homemaker. She served faithfully all her life in the organization of the LDS Church, particularly in Primary as a teacher and in the Relief Society as a visiting teacher. She loved flowers, music and poetry. First and foremost she was a loving, devoted wife and mother to her family.

She is survived by her children: Dennis A (Georgia Dawn) Clegg, Midway; Vern D. (Launa) Clegg and Calvin G. (Dorothy) Clegg, Salt Lake City; Alene (Grant) Misbach, Provo; Almon Hyrum (Janis) Clegg, Cumming, Georgia; LaVar (Janice) Clegg, Scottsdale, Arizona; 35 grandchildren; 42 great-grandchildren; sisters, Barbara Ellen Phillips, Kaysville; Merle Harmon, Manti. She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, and nine brothers and sisters.
